IF WE SET FOR OURSELVES THE TASK OF CONTINUING PDS AS
AN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL, IT OCCURS TO ME THAT WE ARE DISCUSSING
AND UNDERTAKING OF ENORMOUS PROPORTIONS, ONE REQUIRING THE
SUBSTANTIAL AND SUSTAINED EFFORTS OF EVERY PERSON IN THIS
AUDITORIUM.

SO I ASKED MYSELF THIS AFTERNOON, WHY IN THE WORLD I'D BE WILLING TO COMMIT THE KIND OF TIME AND THE KIND OF ENERGY REQUIRED FOR SUCH A PROJECT.

ONLY ONE ANSWER CAME TO ME, AND IT IS THAT THE EDUCATIONAL ALTERNATIVES CURRENTLY AVAILABLE IN THIS COMMUNITY ARE, IN MY MIND AT LEAST, SIMPLY NOT COMPARABLE TO WHAT WE HAVE AT THE DEM SCHOOL.

I BELIEVE IN VERY FEW "OUGHTS", VERY FEW "SHOULDS" IN THIS LIFE, BUT I DO WHOLEHEARTEDLY BELIEVE THAT EDUCATION <u>OUGHT</u>
TO BE NOT ONLY ACADEMICALLY STIMULATING AND CHALLENGING
BUT THAT IT SHOULD ALSO BE ONE OF THE MOST EXCITING ASPECTS
OF A PERSON'S LIFE.

AM SUGGESTING THAT WE HAVE BEEN GIVEN AN UNPARALLELED

OPPORTUNITY TO CREATE A SCHOOL WHICH WILL CONTINUE AND BUILD

UPON THE SPIRIT AND THE STRENGTHS OF THE DEM SCHOOL, AS IT IS

NOW ORGANIZED, BUT WHICH CAN ALSO EMBRACE IDEAS, METHODS,

PHILOSOPHIES THAT ARE EVEN MORE CREATIVE AND FULFILLING

FOR FACULTY AND STUDENTS THAN CURRENTLY EXIST.

I AM SURE EACH PERSON HERE HAS IDEAS ABOUT THE MISSION AND PURPOSE OF SUCH A SCHOOL AND I WOULD HOPE THAT EVERY FACULTY MEMBER, EVERY PARENT, EVERY STUDENT BE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO EXPRESS THESE OPINIONS AND THAT A TRANSITION COMMITTEE WOULD PAY CLOSE ATTENTION TO THEM, IN FORMULATING FURTHER PLANS.

WHAT HAS BEEN SAID TONIGHT SOUNDS EXTREMELY HOPEFUL TO ME, AND FAR FROM SEEING THIS AS A HANDWRINGING, TEAR EVOKING OCCASION, I AM TREMENDOUSLY ENCOURAGED THAT THE SCHOOL WE NOW HAVE A CHANCE TO BUILD WILL BE EVEN MORE EXCITING, MORE SATISFYING, MORE SIGNIFICANT, FOR EACH ONE OF US.
